Anatomy of a two-way integration

- Client-Side APIs: javascript libraries to code against in the browser
- But all of my Servoy biz logic is executed server-side?
- Servoy uses Wicket: an open source ajax engine
- •Servoy offers a public Java API allowing you to write your own wicket components and behaviors and use them in your servoy solutions.



Anatomy of a two-way integration

 You can pass control between your servoy code and your browser code

 Servoy can interact w/ client-side libraries and visa-versa

 We have a plugin! You don't have to learn wicket or write Java code (BORING)
