For Chrome, I still need to try it.

What I have been able to see is that in 5.1.4 as well as 5.2 the cancel button is triggering the callback AFTER the main process is finished. According to Johan, this is due to a change in the way they deal with the Wicket 'EventDispatchThread' and the fact that they are now scheduling events for execution in an event queue rather than executing directly when the test isEventDispatchThread() in WebClient is returning false.

A workaround is under construction but will probably lead to a new kind of call and a new version specific to Servoy 5.1+
