When we start the Smart Client we get the following error in the Java Console:</p> <p>ERROR com.servoy.j2db.util.Debug Jar file of /plugins/velocityreport/commons.jnlp had a jar that doesn't exist: /lib/log4j.jar</p> <p>After some research i've found the fact that Servoy has switched the log4j version and so there is no /lib/log4.jar any more.</p> <p>Can you help me with this issue? What is to do now?</p> <p>Thank you!</p>
