Description

It seems that the JSON parser in the plugin does something weird with JSON that have numbers as a property name. Using `JSON.parse(<json>)` it does work correctly.

Example:

```
var jsonTxt = '{"2":"test value"}';
var vr = plugins.VelocityReport.fromJSON(jsonTxt);
application.output(vr); // --> {2:test value}
application.output(vr['2']); // --> <null>
application.output(vr[2]); // --> <null>
var js = JSON.parse(jsonTxt);
application.output(js['2']); // --> test value
```
