<p>I feel the default provided Cache-Control & Expires HTTP headers of</p> <pre>Cache-Control: max-age=0, must-revalidate, proxy-revalidate</pre> <pre>Expires: 0</pre> <p>work fine in most use cases, however if a programmer wants to adjust them, they cannot.</p> <p>If we attempt to do the following...</p> <pre>responseObject.addHeader('Cache-Control', "max-age=86400, public, no-cache, must-revalidate");</pre> <p>The HTTP header will come back with our string concatenated to the end of the default (which I'm unsure if this is a valid header anymore).</p> <pre>Cache-Control: max-age=0, must-revalidate, proxy-revalidate, max-age=86400, public, no-cache, must-revalidate</pre> <p>So I would propose that if the programmer tries to set a HTTP header that already has a default defined in the plugin that you simply overwrite the default value with the programmer defined one.</p>
