Description			
<p>The servoy treeview bean scrolls to the top after expanding a node and refreshing the tree. This occurs after a node has been expanded, after scrolling down in the tree to a node located in the bottom part of the tree (which initially is located under the active area of the tree).</p> <p>The tree doesn't hold its position to the expanded node but scrolls up. So you manually have to scroll down again to the expanded node.</p> <p>Happens in the webclient using IE and Chrome. In Firefox however it (correctly) does keep (goes back to) the position of the expanded node.</p> <p>Both in servoy developer and regular application server.</p>
